

## HOMECOMING FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### Q: Do NSU Student needs tickets to any events?

A: All active, enrolled, current, NSU students are allowed to every event without a ticket EXCEPT for the Homecoming Bash.

### Q: How much are the tickets for events?

A: Tickets for NSU Homecoming events are **free** except for FSL Stroll Off and the Homecoming Bash. The Stroll Off is \$5 for guests and alumni but **FREE** for NSU Students. The Homecoming Bash is \$50 for NSU students (includes full meal, non-alcoholic drinks, and dessert)

### Q: Are guests allowed?

A: Guest are allowed to ALL events except Shark Bites International Food Festival, Homecoming Bash, and Sharks in the Garden Brunch and unless otherwise stated. ***\*\*Please note guests are not allowed to receive or win giveaways. \*\****

### Q: How many guests are allowed?

A: NSU policy is that each NSU student is allowed two guests at events, unless otherwise determined. This holds true for Homecoming events except the ones were guest are not allowed. ***\*\*Please note to check with each NSU event on their specific event policy, as this is per their event discretion.***

### Q: Where can we purchase guest tickets for FSL Stroll off and tickets for the Homecoming Bash?

A: All tickets are online at [nova.edu/homecoming](http://nova.edu/homecoming) or in the bio of the Office of Campus Life and Student Engagement Instagram page.

### Q: Are we allowed to leave the Pep Rally?

A: **Yes**, but please note that there is no re-entry for the pep rally.

### Q: Are we allowed bags at the Pep Rally and FSL Stroll Off?

A: Please refer to the acceptable bag options on [nova.edu/homecoming](http://nova.edu/homecoming) and the Office of Campus Life and Student Engagement social media (@nsucampuslife).

### Q: What is the Date, Time, and Location of the Homecoming Bash?

A: Date: **Saturday, November 16, 2024**

Time: **7:30 to 11:30 p.m. (times subject to change)**

### Q: Will transportation be provided?

A: Yes, transportation can be provided. Please make sure to indicate that you will need transportation at the time of your ticket purchase. Transportation will depart from the Fort Lauderdale/Davie Campus, Don Taft University Center Shark Circle, **promptly at 6:00 p.m.**

and transportation will be provided for you to return to campus once the yacht has returned to the dock.

**Q: If I do not need transportation, is there parking available?**

**A:** Yes, there are garages that are nearby that will be provided in the confirmation email.

**Q: How can I get a ticket to the Homecoming Bash Yacht Party?**

**A:** You can purchase your ticket online at [www.nova.edu/homecoming](http://www.nova.edu/homecoming) or in the bio link of the Office of Campus Life and Student Engagement Instagram (*@nsucampuslife*)

**Q: What is the cost of the ticket?**

**A:** \$50 (includes full meal, non-alcoholic drinks, and dessert)

**Q: Can I get more than one ticket?**

**A:** Only one ticket per NSU student/purchaser is allowed.

**Q: Who can get a ticket?**

**A:** Currently, enrolled NSU students can purchase a ticket.

**Q: Are non-NSU students allowed to purchase a ticket and attend?**

**A:** No, only current NSU students are allowed to purchase tickets and attend.

**Q: What time does the Yacht depart from the dock?**

**A:** The Yacht will depart from the dock at 7:30 p.m. **(ON TIME)**

**Q: Will I be able to get off the Yacht at any time?**

**A:** Once the Yacht departs from the dock, you will not be able to leave until the yacht returns to the dock at 11:30 p.m. (*time subject to change*)

**Q: What is the attire of the Homecoming Bash Yacht Party?**

**A:** Dress to Impress!

**Q: Will food be provided?**

**A:** Yes, food is included in the price.

**Q: Are alcoholic beverages available?**

**A:** Yes, beer and wine will be available for **CASH ONLY** purchase for adults 21 and older. Government Issued Identification will be required. *\*\*\*Please note all the NSU Student Code of Conduct will apply for this event\*\*\**

**Q: What things are required to get on the yacht?**

**A:** All participants must have their NSU Shark Card, Government Issued ID, NSU Waiver Confirmation, and Event Pass Ready.
