AHRQ	<a href="#">Conference Grant Programs (R13)</a>	Supporting conferences through Single-Year and Multiple-Year Conference grants. AHRQ	<a href="#">Mentored Research Scientist Career Development Award (K01)</a>	Provides support and protected time to individuals with a research doctoral degree for an intensive, supervised research career development experience in health services research. Can be used both by individuals who propose to newly embark in health services research training and those who had a hiatus in their research careers because of illness or family circumstances.	6/12/24  <i>(additional deadlines: 10/12/24, 2/12/25)</i>
AHRQ	<a href="#">Mentored Clinical Scientist Research Career Development Award (K08)</a>	Support an intensive mentored research career development experience, comprised of didactic study and/or mentored research opportunities in health services research, for individuals with clinical doctoral degrees (e.g., MD, DDS, DMD, DO, DC, OD, ND, DVM, PharmD, or PhD in clinical disciplines) through the provision of salary and research support over a sustained period of protected time (3-5 years).	6/12/24  <i>(additional deadlines: 10/12/24, 2/12/25)</i>
