Florida Humanities	Community Project Grants	Provide support to develop engaging public humanities programs and resources that promote a deeper understanding of Florida's diverse cultures, histories, and ideas. Seek proposals that encourage collaboration, dialogue, critical thinking, and foster a sense of shared community.	8/7/24 (additional deadline: 12/4/24)
NEH	Public Humanities Projects	Supports projects that bring the ideas of the humanities to life for general audiences through public programming . Projects must engage humanities scholarship to analyze significant themes in disciplines such as history, literature, ethics, and art history. Includes planning and implementation funding levels as well as the funding categories of exhibitions, historic places, and humanities discussions.	8/14/24
The Arthur Vining Davis Foundations	Private Higher Education Grants	Supports colleges and universities that prioritize undergraduate education and emphasize the liberal arts . Grants typically support projects that improve student outcomes or enhance faculty leadership. Areas	LOI due 8/29/24 (full app due 10/10/24)

NEH	Humanities Connections	Seeks to expand the role of the humanities in undergraduate education by encouraging partnerships between humanities faculty and their counterparts in other areas of study. Projects should plan or implement (either funding level permitted) a curriculum connecting the humanities to one or more non-humanities fields.	9/5/24
ACLS	Fellowships	Invites research proposals from scholars in all disciplines of the humanities and interpretive social sciences . Approximately half of this year's awards will support early-career scholars. Welcomes applications from scholars pursuing research on topics grounded in any time period, world region, or humanistic methodology.	9/25/24
American Philosophical Society	Franklin Research Grants	Designed to help meet the costs of travel to libraries and archives for research purposes; the purchase of microfilm, photocopies, or equivalent research materials ; the costs associated with fieldwork; or laboratory research expenses .	10/1/24 <i>(additional deadline: 12/2/24)</i>
ACLS	Fellowships and Travel Grants in China Studies	Offering fellowships and travel grants to support research, writing, and publicly engaged and creative scholarship in China Studies . There are no restrictions regarding methodological approach or time period.	11/14/24
NEH	Awards for Faculty at Hispanic-Serving Institutions	Awards support individuals pursuing scholarly research that is of value to humanities scholars, students, and/or general audiences. The program welcomes proposals in all areas of the humanities, regardless of geographic or chronological focus.
