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The first few questions are about your alcohol use in the past 90 days. For these questions, we ask people to report their drinking in terms of STANDARD DRINKS.

READ SLOWLY

One 12-ounce bottle/can of regular beer , OR
One 5-ounce glass of regular (12%) wine, OR
1 1/2 ounces of hard liquor either straight or in a mixed drink OR
One 12-ounce wine cooler

Question 3. INTERVIEWER, MODITIE 1 Q2 x Q4 to get. Drinks I et weekdrinks/week (Q3)
Question 6. In the past 90 days, how many days did you drink 5 or more standard drinks in one day? days
(Q6)

Key Variables For A Given Temporal Interval (e.g., per year, per 90 days):

- Days drinking per week
- Drinks per week
- Drinks/drinking day
- Days drinking ≥5 drinks per
