The goal of the Geriatric Fellowship is to provide patient-centered care that is appropriate, compassionate, and effective for treatment of health problems and the promotion of health. The Geriatric Fellow will be involved in consultations and primary care in outpatient, inpatient, clinic, home and nursing home settings. Clinical experiences are provided by an interdisciplinary team of professionals including physicians, nurses, social workers and volunteers.

Geriatric Fellow Learning Objectives

During the one-year Geriatric Fellowship, the trainee will be required to:

- Consult on and care for a broad spectrum of patients with serious illnesses in outpatient, inpatient, clinic, home and nursing home settings.
- Manage administrative patient flow and team coordination.
- Discuss all cases with supervising physicians.
- Supervise residents and medical students on an elective in regards to teaching and consultative activities.
- Provide education to patients and family members regarding diagnosis, treatment, and expected outcomes.
- Participate in Interdisciplinary rounds and team meetings.
- Responsible for maintaining medical records in a timely manner.

Admission Requirements

A Geriatric Fellowship Applicant must have the following:

1. A degree from an accredited osteopathic school.
2. Successful completion of an accredited Osteopathic, Family Medicine, Internal Medicine and Neurology residency program.
3. Licensed in the state of Florida.
4. DEA License.
