## **FAIR**

Ensure content does not include or amplify biases and that it complies with human rights, accessibility, and procedural and substantive fairness obligations.



## **ACCOUNTABLE**

Take responsibility for the content generated. This includes making sure it is factual, legal, ethical, and compliant with the terms of use.



## **SECURE**

Ensure that the infrastructure and tools are appropriate for the security classification of the information and that privacy and personal information are protected.



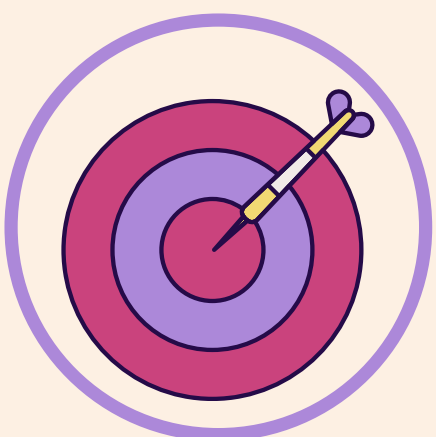
## **TRANSPARENT**

Identify content that has been produced using GAI; notify users that they are interacting with an AI tool; document decisions.



## **EDUCATED**

Learn about strengths, limitations, and responsible use; learn how to create effective prompts and to identify potential weaknesses in the outputs.



## **RELEVANT**

Ensure use of GAI tools supports user and organizational needs and contributes to improved outcomes; AI tools aren't the best choice in every situation.
