

MyNSUPrint Mobility Print for MacOS

Important: Make sure your MacOS device is connected to INSU (Wi-Fi)

1. Go to **System Preferences > Printers and Scanners.**
 2. Click the **+** icon and select a printer. Make sure it's a Bonjour kind of printer.
 3. Check that the **Use** box is set to **Secure Airprint.** If it's not, close the dialog, disconnect and reconnect to the network, then go back to step 2.
 4. Click **Add** and you're ready to print!
- Find something to print and print like you normally do.
 - If you're prompted, type your PaperCut username and password. Your username is usually different from the one that automatically appears in the popup.
