OVERVIEW OF THE PROGRAM

The Student Success Scholars Program is a two-year support program offered to full-time, first-time in college (FTIC) students who fit one or more of the following categories:

- (1) Any students who would benefit from a peer mentorship relationship
 - (2) First Generation in College student
 - (3) Enrolled in preparatory courses
- (4) Advisor identification based on High School performance and/ or standardized scores

This program was established to support student success in and out of the classroom with a focus on mentoring and student's reaching their goals at NSU.
