- V. Peforming the Equivalency Search: To locate specific course equivalencies, enter the course subject and/or the course subject and course number and choose SEARCH.
 - A. Course Code: There are two options available to search fo course equivalencies.
 - **Transfer Course:** This is the default search setting. Use this setting to enter the prior and/or current course subject (for example: BSC) and/or course subject and course number (for example: BSC 2086) from the transfer institution and choose **SEARCH**. In the following example, entering BSC as the search parameter will display all Biology courses at Broward with this course prefix and their respective NSU equivalencies.
